HOLLAND BLINDS

A classic, understated look that enhances both traditional and contemporary room settings can be achieved using holland blinds. Consisting of a single, flat piece of material attached to a bracket suspended roller, the blind can be operated by chain, spring or remote control. Holland blinds can be selected in an exciting range of colours for a traditional look with scallops and braid or the ultra modern look with aluminium base rails. ▲

VERTICAL BLINDS

Vertical blinds allow you to angle the slats to provide light control for any situation with the ability to rotate 180 degrees. Vertical blind slats are available with link chains or chainless sewn in weights and run on a heavy duty tracking system providing a maintenance free and long lasting answer to window dressing. They are easy to care for requiring only a simple wash with warm water and mild detergent. In addition, the ability of vertical blinds to stack to the side or centre of the window allows for fuss-free cleaning of window glass. ▼

SUNSCREEN BLINDS

Sunscreen blinds can be used in conjunction with any window treatment such as curtains or other blinds. Using a dual bracket system with roller blinds provides light and glare control with sunscreen for daytime use and a coordination blackout fabric for night time privacy and complete darkness.

Sunscreen blinds allow you to enjoy the beautiful views whilst maintaining privacy and providing glare control. They provide high levels of ultraviolet protection reducing the amount of harmful ultraviolet sunlight which can be the cause of fading and dulling of furnishings and floor coverings. ▲

VENETIAN BLINDS

Venetian blinds are in a class of their own when it comes to quality and operation. The 25mm and 15mm slats come in a large range of colours and metallic finishes and have the advantage of 0.22mm premium thickness. Venetians are perfect for today's trends in decoration for the home or office and provide security and privacy. ▼



The new mono-command venetian has one control chain that operates both the tilting of slats and the up and down operation in one. ◀



ROMAN BLINDS

One of the most popular choices in the modern market are roman blinds which provide a smart, tailored look to complement an uncluttered décor. Easy to operate, they are backed by a number of parallel horizontal battens that pull the flat piece of fabric up on cords to form neat, streamlined folds.

They are durable and require little maintenance. Stains and dirt spots can be removed with warm water and a mild detergent. ▼



PANEL BLINDS

Panel blinds reflect the desire of modern simplicity. Panel blinds are ideally suited to sliding and bi-fold doors or as a room divider. The fabric panels come in a wide range of decorative colours, textures and transparencies. It is simple to operate via wand or cord controls and the unique tracking system allows the panels to glide effortlessly. ▲

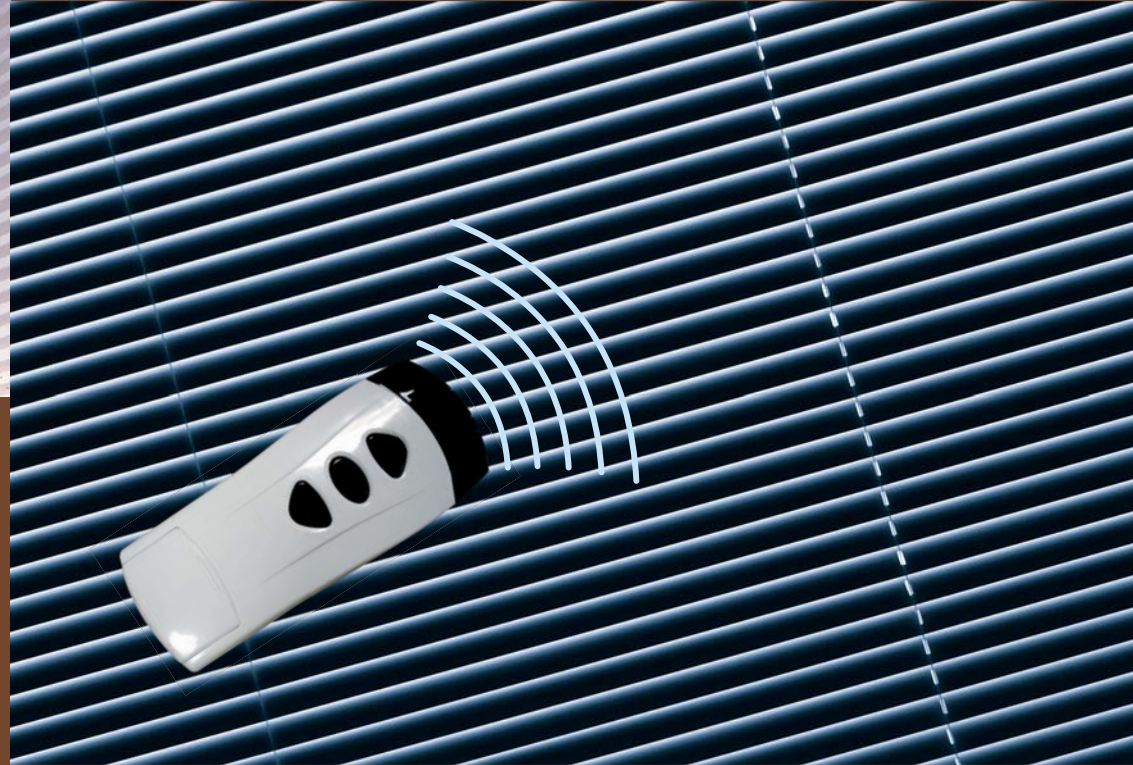


CELLULAR and PLEATED BLINDS

THE ALTERNATIVE OR ACCESSORY TO BLINDS: CURTAINS

Curtains provide insulation, dramatically reducing your heating and cooling costs all year round. A one degree fall in temperature in your home adds 10% to your heating bill. Conversely an increase in temperature in summer adds significantly to the energy required for cooling.

Curtains reduce noise levels outside, improve acoustics inside and provide enhancement to architectural features creating the illusion of height or broadening a room. Create a wonderful ambience and add style, colour, drama, atmosphere and personality to your home.

As well as different styles of window treatments there are a number of headings to choose from that will also have an impact on the final look of your curtains. Select carefully as it is essential to match the heading with the type of fabric you chose for the perfect look.

PENCIL PLEAT

Easy and affordable due to the simple draw-up tape used to create the pleats. ►



PINCH PLEAT

Is a triple pleat that encourages the fabric to hang perfectly in their folds. ►



GROMMET/EYELET

Large eyelets in the top hem allow the rod to be threaded through. ►



When choosing your window treatments it is often easy to forget the importance of appropriate drapery hardware. Curtains can be hung on tracks that can be hand-pull or drawcord or on poles that can be wooden, brass or wrought iron. ►

THE VALANCE

The valance is the most popular and cheapest form of top treatment. Coming in a variety of styles. Valances can be flat, gathered or pleated with the same fabric as your curtains or a contrast, with the addition of decorative trims, frills or piping. ►

THE SWAG

Like the valance, the swag uses soft drapes of fabric over a curtain to form semicircular dips, with a tail of the fabric falling each side of the window like a cascade. Trimmings and trims can be used to add to the look of the swag. ►



THE PELMET

The pelmet creates a more refined and finished look to your window treatments. Trimmings and effects can be added to create a more elegant look. ►
